## Changes to the Use of improper tachograph violation

(menu: Reports -> Infringements and manipulations)

• The violation **Use of improper tachograph** is now generated only for vehicles registered in the European Union, the European Economic Area, Switzerland, the United Kingdom, San Marino, Andorra, and Monaco.

# France - NATINF code and violation Class for missing start/end country entry

(menu: Reports -> Infringements and manipulations)

- A **NATINF** code (26355) and violation class (Class 4) have been added for the violation regarding missing start and end country entries.
  - This violation will appear if the corresponding record is added to the **Administration.csv file**.

### Switzerland - Changes to the Too many work days between weekly rests violation

(menu: Reports -> Infringements and manipulations)

- The violation **Too many work days between weekly rests** is now generated exclusively for self-employed drivers.
  - o The violation period is calculated in full calendar days.
  - o For drivers under an employment contract, the **No weekly rest** violation is generated instead.

#### Switzerland – Changes to the violation No weekly rest (ARV2)

(menu: Reports -> Infringements and manipulations)

- The time threshold for the violation **No weekly rest** has been set to 35 hours.
- The display of the weekly rest violation has been modified on both the weekly and monthly charts:
  - o The violation is now shown across the full week (Monday through Sunday) when the normative rest time is breached.
  - o The violation is also displayed in the violations list.
- These changes apply exclusively to reports generated under ARV2 regulations.
